Composition and Punctuation

The September 11 terrorist attacks have had a more dramatic impact on the tourism industry than any other crisis in recent years. This has generated an atmosphere of uncertainty that has combined with the effects of the global economic downturn. The report is based on information from official tourism organisations around the world, as well as from industry experts. It provides a broad assessment of the impact on tourism markets, and the remedial actions

taken to rebuild consumer confidence and security. The crisis has particularly hit long-haul tourism, airline travel, hotels and the business travel sector. Destinations that depend significantly on US traffic have suffered disproportionately. The report highlights the need for faster compilation and reporting of information on the tourism industry. It finds that, as a result of a continued spirit of co-operation within the industry, tourism should emerge from this crisis fitter, leaner and immeasurably stronger.

Book of Divining the Future

This work is a comprehensive A-Z encyclopedia of the techniques, methods and people involved in predicting the future from Roman augurs to Druid dendromancy, from the ancient I Ching to Nostradamus. Prediction techniques such as rhapsodomancy (sacred books), Ming sticks used in ancient China and still in use today, tasseography (reading of tea leaves) and belomancy (arrows), are fully explained as are their historical backgrounds. The book is illustrated throughout with line drawings and is indexed for ease of use.

The King of Plagues

So much writing about architecture tends to evaluate it on the basis of its intentions: how closely it corresponds to the artistic will of the designer, the technical skills of the builder, or whether it reflects the spirit of the place and time in which it was built, making it not much more than the willful (or even subconscious) assemblage of objects that result from design and construction techniques. Renowned writer and thinker David Leatherbarrow, in this groundbreaking new book, argues for a richer and more profound, but also simpler, way of thinking about architecture, namely on the basis of how it performs. Not simply how it functions, but how it acts, "its manner of existing in the world," including its effects on the observers and inhabitants of a building as well as on the landscape that situates it. In the process, Leatherbarrow transforms our way of discussing buildings from a passive technical or programmatic assessment to a highly active and engaged examination of the lives and performances, intended and otherwise, of buildings.

Public Policy Making

This newly updated book is a response to the oft-perpetrated myths of British Jewry's lack of fighting spirit and its failure to participate in the Second World War.

British Jewry has never formed more than about one half of 1% of the population, yet the figures show that their contribution to the armed forces has always been out of proportion to their numbers. *Fighting Back* provides insight into the Anglo-Jewish contribution to the Allied victories over the Nazi and Japanese threats. The book highlights the role of the Jews in the Spanish Civil War and the Korean War. Its wide-ranging approach to the contributions that Jews made looks at, among other things: the paratroopers at the Battle of Arnhem; the much neglected and almost forgotten Auxiliary Services of Civil Defense; the Jews at Bletchley Park; and the Jewish-Palestinian volunteers from Israel. Anglo-Jewry, together with Jews from Israel, may thus be deeply and justly proud of this history of fighting back, fighting for democracy, and fighting for peace.
